Join us on Saturday, May 28th at Royal Ashburn Golf Club. Home to the Canadian Tour Fall Qualifying School, is ranked among the top 50 public golf courses in Canada. A mature, traditional style layout featuring tree-lined fairways, well-guarded greens, several well placed ponds and the beautiful Lynde Creek, which winds its way throughout the property. Come early and attend a complimentary mini rules seminar presented by your fellow EWGA members. Learn the basic rules of golf and how to get a ruling on some not so basic rules. This championship course is delicately carved through 146 acres of rolling landscape and is as pretty as it is challenging and located only minutes outside of Guelph. Designed by golf course architect David Moote, great care was taken to make full use of the land's natural assets, as can be seen by the environmentally sensitive area that bisects the golf course and comes into play on six of the 18 holes. What are PAR Points?

The Participation and Recognition Program (PAR) is an EWGA-Canada GTA Chapter program. Each time an EWGA-Canada GTA member plays golf at a member course, attends a weekend or weekday event, volunteers for the GTA Chapter, or recruits a new member or sponsor they are awarded points. Each month, the GTA Chapter member with the most points wins a \$25.00 GolfTown gift certificate. The Border Cup, our annual competition with the Greater Detroit Area Chapter of EWGA, team is selected by inviting the EWGA-Canada GTA members with the most points from the previous season.

Since the EWGA-Canada GTA Chapter is a member organization, we rely on our members to volunteer. Points are awarded for volunteering throughout the year and at the end of the season the member with the most volunteer points is awarded the Volunteer of the Year award.

Since member recruitment relies heavily on our existing members, each time an EWGA-Canada GTA members recruits a new member, points will be awarded. The more members that you recruit to our sub-chapter, the more points that you will receive. In addition, if you recruit a new sponsor for EWGA-Canada GTA you will receive PAR points.

The process for awarding points is on the website and if you want to monitor your own points, the list is updated each month and posted on-line. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact any Board member for more information.
